1. The Judge addresses the court, announcing the rules of procedure and setting the tone, establishing the purpose of the trial.
2. An Attorney for the Prosecution presents an Opening Statement to the Court (2 mins.)
3. An Attorney for the Defence presents an Opening Statement to the Court (2 mins.)
4. Prosecution
Witness 1: 3 minutes Cross:2 minutes Redirect: 1 minute

5. Defence

8. Clarification questions from the jury (5 mins)
9. Jury meets to establish verdict based on EVIDENCE presented during the trial.
10. Judge presents the Verdict at the end of the class.
